To access, go to <http://www.worldwidewhiteboard.com/dashboard/ucf>, use the drop down menu to choose the appropriate course, type in your name, and click “Enter Dashboard.” Once you are inside the Dashboard, click “Join Live Class” to launch the WorldWideWhiteboard™.

System Requirements

There are no custom installations or third party downloads required, and the WorldWideWhiteboard™ supports all popular browsers on both Windows and Macintosh platforms. To test your system to make sure it meets the system requirements:
